

## **Action Verbs Activity**

- 1. Explain to your child that this is a movie clapper. They are used for very famous actors when they are making a new film. It tells them when to start acting and the director will say "3, 2, 1...ACTION!"
- 2. Today you are going to be very famous actors and you are going to take it in turns to act out some different present tense action verbs!
- 3. Brainstorm the action verbs that you are going to act out and write each one onto a strip below.
- 4. One at a time, stick your action verb onto the movie clapper and take it in turns to count each other in (sticking them on rather than writing them onto the clapper, will allow you to change the action more easily each time). When you hear the word "ACTION!" you must create a scene where you act out the verb. For example you may choose the verb 'dance', so you could pretend you are at a party.

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
