## **Super Potion Experiment**



Have fun creating your own superhero potions, but remember, these potions are for effect and not to actually drink.

- bowls or small containers
- teaspoon
- white vinegar

bicarbonate

of soda

food colouring

## Instructions

ou Will Neeo

- 1. Put a teaspoon of bicarbonate of soda in each bowl.
- 2. Add a drop of food colouring to each bowl. You could try one colour, a range of colours or even adding a combination of colours to each potion.
- 3. Add a teaspoon of white vinegar to each bowl.
- 4. Carefully mix the potion.
- 5. Watch the magic reaction!



Vinegar is an acid. When an acid mixes with a base, such as bicarbonate of soda, they react. A gas called carbon dioxide is released, which causes the fizzing sound.

## **Science Experiment**

- You could experiment with different amounts of bicarbonate of soda and vinegar. How does this change the reaction of the super potion?
- Does the amount of food colouring change the outcome? Why do you think this is?
