Toilet Roll Owl


You will need:

- Toilet paper roll
- Piece of orange card
- Owl Template
- White glue (such as PVA)
- Glue spreader
- Plate for glue

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Wrapping paper or coloured paper (optional)
- 2 googly eyes (optional)



What To Do:





In preparation, print out the Owl Template. Please note: If you feel confident drawing the template shapes out yourself you can skip this step.



Place the toilet paper roll on to the wrapping paper or coloured paper.

Starting at one end of the paper, roll the toilet paper tube over the paper and mark with a pencil how much paper you need to cover your tube.



Using the scissors, carefully cut the piece of wrapping paper to size, making sure that you allow for an extra 2cms to fold into the tube.







Glue the wrapping paper on to the tube. Next, gently fold down the excess paper into the centre of the tube.





Carefully push down one side of the top of the toilet paper roll into the middle. Repeat on the other side so both parts are overlapping.



Carefully cut out the owl's beak and wings from the Owl Template, or draw and cut your own onto card and cut them out.



Glue the owl's beak and googly eyes on to the tube. If you don't have googly eyes, you can use the eyes from the Owl Template, or draw your own.



Finally, fold down the top section of each wing and glue to the sides of the tube.






Toilet Roll Owl

Step 1

In preparation, print out the Owl Template. Please note: If you feel confident drawing the template shapes out yourself you can skip this step.






Step 2

Step 3

Step 4

Carefully push down one side of the top of the toilet paper roll into the middle. Repeat on the other side so both parts are overlapping.







Step 6

Template, or draw and cut your own onto card and cut them out.





Step 7

Glue the owl's beak and googly eyes on to the tube. If you don't have googly eyes, you can use the eyes from the Owl Template, or draw your own.







Step 8

Finally, fold down the top section of each wing and glue to the sides of the tube.
